Post-Disaster Mitigation, Floodproofing and Infrastructure Protection: A More Flood Resilient Society

August 14 - 17, 2017 | Renaissance Woodbridge Hotel, Iselin, New Jersey

OVERVIEW

Flooding is the nation's #1 hazard. Add to that critical infrastructure and development that is at either moderate or high risk of flooding and it is easy to understand why flood recovery costs to our society keep increasing. How do we mitigate against this flood risk? How do we make sure existing and new development becomes more resilient to flood hazards?

The National Flood Mitigation and Nonstructural Flood Proofing Workshop focuses on these questions. During the workshop you will learn tools, techniques and best practices that the nation's leading floodplain managers, engineers, architects, designers, emergency managers, property managers, owners and others can use to reduce flood risk.



LOCATION

For the first time in its history the workshop will be held in the mid-Atlantic – Northeastern region of the country, five years after Hurricane Sandy. Many speakers will highlight work and policy related to Sandy recovery efforts, but this is a national workshop with a national slate of speakers. The Wednesday tours will also highlight Hurricane Sandy recovery and mitigation progress during the five years since one of the area's most catastrophic storms.

Iselin, New Jersey is one Amtrak stop south of Newark International Airport and just a short train ride from Metro Park Amtrak Station to New York City's Penn Station. Come early or stay late and enjoy a late summer weekend in the Big Apple!

PROGRAM

The workshop begins on Monday afternoon with half-day technical workshops followed by an evening reception. Tuesday and Thursday feature plenary sessions, mini-workshops and breakout concurrent sessions offering detailed presentations on engineered mitigation and flood-proofing projects, policy, grant funding, natural and beneficial uses including stream restoration, mitigation planning and outreach. In keeping with tradition, all attendees are encouraged to participate in our Wednesday technical tours to see techniques applied in the field. Exhibitors will display their state-of-the-art materials, services, equipment, accessories and techniques early in the week at ASFPM's first ever "Cracker Barrel" Tuesday evening. Plenty of time is planned for attendees to exchange ideas and view the exhibits, so opportunities to network will be ample!
