

NFIP Regulations

For all type of disasters NFIP regulations enforced in the Special Flood Hazard Area.

Increased Cost of Compliance (ICC) only available on a flood disaster, flood insurance policy holder.



Risks

- Special Flood Hazard Area How many structures in the SFHA.
- What resources do your residents have to recover from disaster – flood insurance policies, home owners policies.
- How many structures have their lowest floor below the Base Flood Elevation (BFE).
