The purpose of this reference guide is to provide a selection of higher development standards that can be adopted by a community or state to reduce flood impacts, losses and insurance rates and provide guidance for mitigation efforts. The committee will promote the use of this guide for local floodplain managers seeking higher standards with a particular emphasis on communities recovering from recent extreme floods and at risk of extreme flooding resulting from climate change.
