COMMITTEE NAME NOTE:

The evolution of floodplain management towards many of the flood damage reduction being addressed by major building codes, and the fact that the National Flood Insurance Program Regulations have not been revised in 25 years has created interest in a Committee name change. Rather than "Floodplain Regulations" Committee, a name such as "Floodplain Management Codes, Regulations, and Standards" might be more reflective of actual Committee work.
